GO NOW stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over on the far turn and drew clear, then was fully extended to prevail. MR. MABEE tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then rallied to prove second best while unable to catch the winner. SUMMER BOOK moved up to vie for the lead outside BOB'S PROUD MOMENT down the backstretch and into the far turn, continued on well into the stretch, then tired. VICTORY CIRCLE reserved early, moved into contention four wide around the far turn but had no late response. GOLD MAGIC unhurried after being bounced around between rivals at the start, made a run four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then flattened out. NIIGON failed to menace. FOURTY NINERS SON reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. AUTUMN EXPRESS bumped with GOLD MAGIC and steadied at the start, then was not a factor. SAMIR was outrun while racing four wide. ANWAR bumped with GOLD MAGIC and steadied at the start, raced in striking position while saving ground into the far turn, then faded. ACTXPEDITITE allowed to settle, was saving ground when steadied on the far turn and gave way. BOB'S PROUD MOMENT rushed up from the outside to gain the lead, responded when challenged by SUMMER BOOK on the backstretch, vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn, stopped and was eased in the stretch run.
