Footnotes

YOU AND I FOREVER rated off the pace, rallied five wide to take over at the top of the stretch, then edged away under pressure. MOTOVATO stalked the pace, angled in leaving the quarter pole, slipped through inside INKADO along the rail at the top of the stretch to make a run at the winner but couldn't stay with that rival while continuing on with good courage for the place. COOL COAL MAN pressed the pace three wide, moved to gain a brief lead at the quarter pole, then weakened in the drive. SUPREME SUMMIT tracked the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. HARLEM ROCKER unhurried after breaking slowly, advanced into contention five wide around the turn but had no further response. CONGRESSIONAL PAGE failed to menace. INKADO pressed the pace outside LE GRAND CRU, gained a slim lead soon after entering the turn, made the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. THIS ONES FOR PHIL chased the pace four wide around the turn and faltered. PAST THE POINT stalked the pace along the rail into the turn, then faded. LE GRAND CRU set the pace under pressure along the rail to the turn, then had nothing left. GRASSHOPPER was outrun.
