Footnotes

CODE OF CONDUCT reserved racing along the inside, swung out leaving the far turn, rallied to catch JUPITER inside the eighth pole and won going away. JUPITER rated along the inside, angled three wide for room on the far turn, rallied to take over soon after entering the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. GET A GRIP (IRE) stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. DYNAMIC BOY set the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. FINANCIAL PATHWAY was no factor after being checked in the early going. NO CALCETINES raced three wide and faltered. SCOTTISH COAST was outrun and vanned off after the finish. DISTINCTIVE PIC chased the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then faded.
