BETTY'S STAR sprinted clear racing off the rail and was all out to hold off SECRET HILLS. The latter, chased the pace three wide, drew even in late stretch and just missed. HEARTBUSTER stalked the pace along the rail, lugged in through the stretch run and weakened. GAMBLING THYME unhurried early, passed tired rivals. SKETCH OF ROSE, in tight at the start, failed to menace. MYCUPOFTEA chased the pace between horses and tired. PHONE SIGNAL was outrun while racing wide. SCANDALS faded while four wide around the turn. MCKENZIE SUE was through early.
