SEATTLE NIGHT reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. PERFECT STRANGER unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. WORLDWIND ROMANCE outrun after breaking slowly, closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. PUNKIN HEAD chased the pace three wide into the stretch, made a run to join the leaders in midstretch, then tired. KICK BOXER (FR) well placed, made a run between horses in the stretch, then faltered. A. P. DELTA chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then gave way. JO JO'S BOY saved ground to no avail. JEB'S STRATEGY showed speed along the inside, continued on well into the stretch and faded.
