LADY PRANTLACK unhurried early, rallied four wide to take over at the top of the stretch and drew away under a hand ride. SEATTLE TAC well placed racing along the rail, steadied twice on the far turn losing good position, then came on again along the inside to be up for the place. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE outrun while saving ground, steadied in traffic on the far turn, angled out in the stretch and closed with a belated rally to just miss the place. CATALINA CAT rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch, then weakened. GREY BOUQUET failed to menace after being outrun early. MEADOW BELLE chased the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch and faltered. OUR MARIAH set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch and gave way. ONEMOREFASHION raced in striking position into the far turn and faded. DEVILISH AMOUR was through early and eased in the stretch run.
