DELTA PRINCESS reserved after being checked when caught in tight leaving the chute, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied to be just up at the wire. COZY ISLAND chased the pace, rallied to catch PRIME QUEEN at the eighth pole and edged clear, then just failed to last. PRIME QUEEN showed speed along the rail, opened a long lead racing down the backstretch, then weakened in the drive. HERMANS HONOR rated off the pace, eased out for the drive and lacked the needed response. RUSSIAN SWEETIEPIE well placed while saving ground, advanced into contention on the far turn, then tired in the drive. LA CROISSETTE (CHI) steadied when caught in tight leaving the chute, then saved ground to no avail. BAIL MONEY raced three wide and failed to be a factor. TRUE GLITTER showed nothing.
