Footnotes

ORLEANS ROAD took the lead soon after the start, extended his advantage along the backstretch, maintained a clear lead into upper stretch, dug in when challenged in deep stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. SPAGHETTI HOUSE (GB) was unhurried for five furlongs, launched a strong bid while four wide on the turn, rapidly gained to challenge in deep stretch but couldn't get by the winner. DONTHELUMBERTRADER raced in close contention while three wide into upper stretch and held well for a share. TARQUIN JOE saved ground to the turn, closed the gap entering the stretch then finished evenly. DOUBLETHEBETWICE raced in the middle of the pack for six furlongs, was in traffic on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. EDDIE B RUNS was never a factor while saving ground. STEAK SCAM checked early, failed to threaten while five wide on the turn. TIMEKEEPER moved up before going a half, checked in traffic in upper stretch then gave way. BEAU DANCER gave way after going five furlongs.
