UNRESTRAINED reserved early, rallied racing down the backstretch, took over soon after entering the far turn, then drew off through the stretch under urging. QUIET LAKE rated off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn to reach the attending position but was no match for the winner while holding the place. AMADA unhurried after breaking slowly, closed to gain the show. EAST IS EAST set the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. SPRING PLACE was never a factor. HUNTING VALLEY up close early, saved ground and faltered. GOOD HUMOR showed little. SWEETEST STAR prompted the pacesetter into the backstretch, stopped and was eased in the final eighth. Fractional times for this race were hand timed. Final time for this race was timed electronically.
