JUST RIGHT ASHLEY well placed while saving ground, angled out and made a run at the winner in the stretch, then continued on with good courage while being edged to the wire. CREDIT GAL rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and gained the show. WORTHY YOU made the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and weakened. DREAM DANCER outrun early, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. LUV U ME chased the pace three wide and faltered. MISS BO BLUSH was outrun. ME GOTTA GO saved ground and faded.
