WHAT A PAL chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the turn, then was fully extended to prevail. SOARING STORM chased the pace, angled outside the leaders for the drive and closed to prove second best while unable to get to the winner. JALAPENO HEAT unhurried after breaking slowly, circled rivals four wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. SOUTHERN WARNING pressed the pace outside GALLO RUSSO, responded when headed by WHAT A PAL, continued on well to nearing the eighth pole, then tired. RAHY RIDGE saved ground and faltered. WATCH TWEETY tracked the pace three wide around the turn and faded. MORNING CHOIR was not a factor. TRUE TO REASON was outrun after stumbling at the start. GALLO ROSSO showed speed along the rail, then took a bad step on the turn, eased and was vanned off after the finish.
