BUD chased the pace four wide, moved to take over on the turn and continued on with good courage while unable to resist the winner late. TEN PAST TEN rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. STRAIGHT FAX reserved off the pace, swung wide for the stretch run and couldn't gain on the top ones. PLAY EIGHTEEN raced wide throughout and failed to threaten. EVOLUTION ROCKS showed speed along the inside to midway of the turn, then tired. NONNO'S BOY pressed the pace outside EVOLUTION ROCKS to midway of the turn and faltered.
