BALANCE THE BUDGET broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to chase the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be up in time. ACT ONE SCENE ONE bumped hard with IRON POST at the start, showed speed off the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. LARGE KAUFY tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then finished willingly. SHERIFF IRA chased the pace three wide into the turn, then tired. IRON POST bounced around between rivals at the start, was no factor while racing four wide. UNO AGAIN off slowly, was outrun. DONT MESWIT GOLDIE showed little after bumping IRON POST soundly at the start. CONGRATS CRIMINAL showed early foot and faltered. LANCE'S SONG was done early.
