COIN BROKER stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over midway of the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to remain clear to the wire. HARRIS set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then couldn't stay with the winner, angled out and continued on with good courage to be clearly best of the rest. CARY STREET rated off the pace, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. SECRET BID prompted the pace outside HARRIS to midway of the far turn and tired. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY was never a factor. ELMUTAHID tracked the leaders into the far turn and faltered. GRAD STUDENT was outrun. RULE NUMBER SIX off slowly, saved ground and faded.
