POWERFUL PACKAGE tracked the pace, moved to the leader leaving the far turn, took over at the eighth pole and edged away under pressure. K. C.'S GIFT made the pace along the inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch and again entering the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner clearly second best. MARTINIQUE well placed after bumping with ELLESMERE soon after the start, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then tired in the drive. CHEROKEE IN SOLANO rated off the pace while saving ground, angled out for the stretch run and faltered. TOPPENISH failed to menace. YOUR SONG was outrun. PICTURESOFMEMORIES chased the pace into the far turn and faded. CURIOUS CALL showed little. TOUGH RAMBLER was through early. ELLESMERE bumped with MARTINIQUE and stumbled early, made a run from the outside to reach the lead racing down the backstretch, then stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
