Footnotes

DROMARA outrun early, advanced into contention between horses on the far turn, angled out for the drive and rallied to be up late. LOVELY LADY chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead between horses and eighth pole and continued on with good courage while being outfinished by the winner. PYRITE MISSY reserved early, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to gain the show. DOVE CREEK allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. SPARKLING NUMBER chased the pace, made a run to reach the leaders in midstretch, then gave way. SHOULDNT WE ALL made the pace along the rail to nearing the eighth pole and tired. SEATTLE CHRISTMAS well placed while saving ground, checked in behind a wall of horses late and failed to recover. MINERVA failed to menace. PENTHOUSE SUITE was never a factor. TWIRLING ANGEL steadied in the early going and was outrun. BULL RIDE chased the pace three wide, then drifted out leaving the far turn and faded. NEVER A SAINT was through early.
