TAP DANCE bumped with SERENE DITTY at the start, moved up quickly to make the pace racing off the rail, drew clear racing down the backstretch, then was under steady pressure to remain clear when her rider lost his whip nearing the sixteenth pole. HALO REALITY chased the winner into the stretch but was no match for that rival while holding the place. UNBRIDLED LASSIE reserved off the pace, saved ground and outfinished the others for the show. INDY GLORY failed to menace. HAPPILY UNBRIDLED checked along the inside entering the first turn and was never a factor. LASTING SENSATION showed little. SERENE DITTY hit the gate at the start bumping with TAP DANCE, chased the pace three wide into the far turn and faded.
