Footnotes

HARLAN'S HOLIDAY rated off the pace, rallied three wide to gain command on the far turn, then was put to pressure while drawing clear. BLUE BURNER taken in hand and angled in to race off the rail soon after the start, rallied three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while clearly second best. PEEKSKILL unhurried while saving ground, angled out on the far turn and closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. BOOKLET hustled to get the lead, set the pace under pressure off the rail, edged away from SMOOTH JAZZ on the far turn, then had nothing left for the stretch run. MONTHIR tracked the pace, then steadied to avoid running up on the tiring SMOOTH JAZZ on the far turn, angled to the inside and tired in the drive. D' COACH angled in soon after the start, came out to race four wide on the far turn, then drifted in a bit at the top of the stretch and was not a factor. NOKOMA allowed to settle, saved ground and faltered. HIGH STAR failed to menace. PUCK showed some early foot, then was through after a half mile. SMOOTH JAZZ forced the pace outside BOOKLET into the far turn, then faded. PERSONAL REWARD raced four wide around the first turn and was done early.
