VESPERS allowed to settle, angled to the outside entering the stretch, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. I MET SOMEBODY steadied when caught in tight on the first turn, tracked the pace, eased outside the leaders at the top of the stretch and closed to be up for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. LADY LINDA unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally for the show. FIVE FISHES (FR) reserved racing along the inside, altered course to the outside for racing room in midstretch and closed with a mild response. NOTABLE CRAFT prompted the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn and edged away, then weakened in the final sixteenth. SHY DORY (ARG) set the pace along the rail into the far turn and tired. TIGER BABE steadied and rank in the early going, chased the pace, made a run at the lead three wide on the far turn, then faltered in the drive.
