Footnotes

LETSRINGTHEBELL reserved along the rail, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and drew clear. HANDS WAVERING allowed to settle, saved ground around the turn, angled out for the drive and rallied to prove second best. HOME ALONA bumped with both UNITY CALLING and TOP LIMIT at the start, moved up quickly to show speed along the rail into the stretch, then tired. TOP LIMIT bumped with HOME ALONA at the start, chased the pace, rallied to take over leaving the turn, made the pace to inside the eighth pole, then faltered. UNITY CALLING was no factor after being bumped at the start. GIN PLEASE showed early foot, raced three wide on the turn and faded. BELLA STELLA was outrun.
