STRATHNAVER (GB) rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to take over in the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. TABREED (GB) off slowly, was unhurried while saving ground, angled out for room in the stretch and closed well to be up for the place. TREE HUGGER stalked the pace, slipped through along the rail racing into the far turn to gain the lead, made the pace into the stretch, then gave way grudgingly. SEX APPEAL well placed after being steadied briefly in the early going, had no late response. DOUBLE BERG contested the slow early pace off the rail, responded when TREE HUGGER moved to the fore, then tired leaving the far turn. BENITA BLUE raced with the pace to nearing the far turn, then faltered. EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE contested the slow pace outside DOUBLE BERG into the far turn and faded.
