WHY KATHERINE set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then drew off under a strong hand ride. MINX chased the winner off the rail into the stretch but was no match for that rival while saving the place. AUNTIE MARTHA rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention but couldn't keep pace with the winner while gaining some ground on the runner-up. ZIPSO FACTO failed to menace. WIN FOR KITTEN stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then tired. MAGICAL WORLD was not a factor. ABBEY STREET raced three wide and faltered. SPRING REASON raced three wide and was through after a half mile.
