WAR TRACE unhurried after stumbling at the start, altered course to the outside at the top of the stretch, then closed fast to be just up at the wire. ECCLESIASTIC stalked the pace along the inside, came out and split rivals inside the eighth pole to gain the lead but couldn't hold off the winner in the final strides. ELUSIVE KNIGHT tracked the pace, made a run to reach the leaders in midstretch, then weakened. CLASSIC PIPER outrun early, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn, then flattened out in the drive. CHI TOWN vied for the lead outside THE MOUNT to inside the eighth pole and tired. INSILVER rated in striking position off the pace, had no late response. BORIS JORDAN saved ground and failed to menace. AFAR reserved early, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then faltered and was vanned off after the finish. AMERICAN TOKEN was not a factor. THE MOUNT vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch and faded.
