OMAGGIO set the pace along the inside, drew clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to hold off NEUF DE CARREAU. The latter, rated off the pace, closed well in the drive to prove second best while unable to run down the winner. PITCHNICHOLAS outrun early, raced three wide around the far turn and

rallied to be up for the show. DREAM ON DREAM ON chased the winner into the stretch and gave way. HALF MASK reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and improved his position. CHAMPAGNE BRUNCH allowed to settle, gained some ground without threatening. I'VE GOT SPEED failed to menace. I'MROYALLYMECKE'D outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed ground late. DAKOTA MAX saved ground to no avail. SIR VINSKY was not a factor. DANCING IN GERARDA steadied along the inside on the first turn, chased the pace along the inside into the far turn, then gave way. REEF POINT chased the pace into the far turn and faltered.
