ARROW'S FLIGHT chased the pace three wide, eased out for the drive, moved up to engage the leaders at the eighth pole, gained a slim advantage nearing the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to hold off IL DIVO. The latter, tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. DELAWARE MANOR vied for the lead three wide to inside the eighth pole, then gave way grudgingly. ZAPPER vied for the lead along the inside to the eighth pole, then tired. STRONG N SILENT vied for the lead between horses to midway of the turn, then faltered. SLEEK JOHN was not a factor. ZEKE saved ground and faded. QUIET REVOLUTION steadied from tight quarters in the early going, trailed and was eased in the stretch run.
