### Footnotes

TEMPEST STORM tracked the pace three wide, rallied to catch OMEGA GIRL nearing the eighth pole, then edged away under urging. GIBSON CRYSTAL rated off the pace, rallied to be up for the place. VERSE CHOIR reserved early, advanced four wide around the turn to reach contention but couldn't gain late while up for the third. MISSY MINER allowed to settle, angled out for the drive and closed with a mild response. OMEGA GIRL pressed the pace along the rail, moved to take over on the turn, made the pace into the stretch and gave way. SHE'S HOT HOT tracked the early pace along the inside, dropped back racing around the turn, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch, then steadied to avoid running up on OMEGA GIRL at the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. SLEETCALLING set the pace under pressure outside OMEGA GIRL to nearing the quarter pole, then couldn't stay with that one and tired in the drive. SHIFT IT was not a factor.
