Footnotes

ETERNAL RULER (IRE) stalked the pace along the inside, eased out in the stretch, then rallied and split rivals to be up late. HA LONG BAY stalked the pace three wide, rallied to reach even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. OUR NOBLE HEART bumped with BEAMER at the start, set the pace along the rail to the sixteenth pole and weakened. BEAMER reserved off the pace after being steadied when bumped between rivals at the start, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied to just miss the show. ENDURING STAR rated off the pace, finished willingly without really threatening. MR. IRONS unhurried while saving ground, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. POSITIVE SIDE chased the pace to inside the eighth pole and gave way. BADLEROIIBROWN bumped with BEAMER at the start, tracked the leaders to nearing the stretch but had no response when asked.
