CRAZY WOMAN reserved racing along the rail, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and prevailed. PRECISE DANCING rated off the pace after bumping with WYATT'S WOMEN at the start, rallied to take over on the far turn, made the pace to inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. NENA BELLA stalked the pace, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't gain late and was vanned off after the finish. BOCA MARY allowed to settle after being pinched back soon after the start, finished willingly. AQUALINA well placed in behind the leaders raced three wide around the far turn and didn't do enough late. SEABROOK CHARMER unhurried after being steadied to avoid WYATT'S WOMEN on the first turn, found her best stride late. ALWAYS IN set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired. NAIANA chased the pace for a half mile and faltered. PREMIERLOVEAFFAIR chased the pace to nearing the far turn, then faded. WYATT'S WOMEN bumped with PRECISE DANCING at the start, then stumbled racing into the first turn and was pulled up.
