RATHER CLEVER set the pace along the rail, drew clear soon after entering the stretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. CHAYSEN' ALEX was steadied to avoid running up on rivals racing into the first turn, saved ground to nearing the top of the stretch, angled out and rallied to prove second best. BIG AL reserved off the pace, angled in to cut the corner leaving the far turn, then closed with a mild response to gain the show. LABERINTO (URU) unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. MONASHEE GOLD (IRE) stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. JUST LIKE BISCUIT rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. COME UNDONE chased the winner into the stretch and faltered. MR. RICO failed to menace. RUN SMART ONE hit the rail entering the first turn and was not a factor. TURNPIKE TOMMY chased the pace to midway of the far turn, then faded.
