**Footnotes**

GAME BALL unhurried while saving ground, swung out leaving the far turn, then rallied to be just up at the wire. SIR RABBIT stalked the the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a brief lead in deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. TANZANA set the pace along the rail to deep stretch and weakened. CANTONIC off slowly, was rank under restraint in the early going, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then flattened out. DAVID K reserved racing along the inside, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but had no further response. TRULY DISTINCTIVE prompted the pace outside TANZANA to past the eighth pole, then gave way. TYLER'S WILDCAT rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. PAISANO CREEK was no factor after being caught in tight at the start. KRIS AND ME allowed to settle, made a run five wide around the far turn, then faltered. CRISTOBAL tracked the pace into the far turn and faded.
