FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 additional to start, with \$100,000 guaranteed. The owner of the winner will receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$11,000 to third, \$6,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over on the turf, allowed 2 lbs.; \$40,000 at any distance or \$30,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; \$24,000 at any distance or \$18,000 at a mile or over, 6 lbs. Trophy to winning Owner. In the event this stake race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Wednesday March 8, 2006 with 24 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth) (Rail at 72 feet).

### Footnotes

AUNT HENNY rank for the first half mile while taken in hand to stalk the pace, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to last over DIAMOND SPIRIT. The latter, rated off the pace, advanced into contention three wide around the far turn, then was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. MISS SHOP tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. MUSICAL CHARM reserved in striking position into the far turn, couldn't keep pace in the drive. LAKE ALICE rank while moving to the fore racing into the first turn, set the pace along the inside into the far turn and faltered.
