TEMPT FORTUNE in hand while setting the pace along the inside, responded when BLUE MON came to him along the rail a couple of times, opened a clear in midstretch, then was under pressure to hold off HARD DECK. The latter, reserved off the pace for more than a mile, angled out for the drive and was gaining on the winner at the finish. BLUE MON angled in racing down the stretch the first time to chase the leader along the rail, was steadied trying to get through inside that rival on the clubhouse turn and again on the final turn, then weakened in the drive. OH SO AWESOME unhurried into the final turn, closed with a mild response without threatening. AMBASSADOR DAN stalked the pace three wide into the stretch the final time, then gave way. GROWING WILD stalked the leaders into stretch the final time and tired. GRAND AND WARREN allowed to settle, made a run on the final turn to reach contention, then faltered. PRIVATE ALERT was through after a mile.
