**Footnotes**

NO FLY ZONE showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when asked. PRINCE STEVE rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat but was no match for the winner while closing to be up for the place. DEPUTY DANCE chased the winner three wide into the stretch and gave way. HALL PASS pressed the early pace along the rail, then couldn't stay with the winner and tired in the drive. MILES AND MILES raced three wide and failed to menace. RAPID RATE bumped with LETTERMAN'S HUMOR at the start and was not a factor. THE MIDNIGHT SKIER was chasing the pace when steadied from between rivals nearing the quarter pole and faltered. CAPTAIN BACKFIRE saved ground to no avail. LETTERMAN'S HUMOR was outrun after being steadied when bumped by RAPID RATE at the start. BROWN DIRT COWBOY rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and faded.
