HUMAITA (GER) rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn, moved to gain a slim lead nearing the eighth pole and was fully extended to edge BITTERROOT RIVER to the wire. The latter, allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the final turn to reach near even terms for command inside HUMAITA in the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. CANDY VERSE sprinted to a clear lead racing along the hedge, made the pace to deep stretch and was outfinished. MORALUNA outrun early, raced three wide on the final turn and closed with a belated rally. STARS GO BLUE taken in hand to track the pace along the hedge, weakened in the drive. DANIA BAY stalked the leaders three wide into the final turn and faltered. RINGAROUNDAROSIE was not a factor. FLYING PASSAGE was outrun. KEY DEFINITION chased the pacesetter for a mile and faded.
