CONFEDERATE LADY stalked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead just inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. RAPTUROUS stalked the pace three wide, was outmoved by the winner into the stretch, then was gaining on that rival late. VIA rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. WALL STREET LEGEND set the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. ASPIRING LANA chased the pace into the stretch, then weakened. VILLAGE QUEEN unhurried early, gained some ground without threatening. POSEY COUNTY GAL reserved in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. QUITE THE LIGHT was done early. LADY DANCING off slowly, saved ground and tired. FESTIVAL QUEEN broke slowly, took a bad step in the early going and was pulled up.
