JACQUI'S PROMISE rank while reserved in behind NORTHERN LANE around the first turn, angled outside the leaders on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and edged away. MERCY MATTERS allowed to settle, rallied along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. NORTHERN LANE set the pace along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and weakened. HAY CHEIF rated off the pace, lacked a late response. SPIRITUAL DRIFT tracked the pace into the far turn and tired. TIFFANY'S RODEO prompted the pace outside NORTHERN LANE to nearing the stretch, then faltered.
