D' FUNNYBONE away alertly, showed speed off the rail, drew clear under a hand ride in early stretch, then was roused late to hold IBBOYEE. The latter, unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed well for the place. PRIVILAGED pressed the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then was weakening when his rider lost his whip at the sixteenth pole. HEAR YE HEAR YE showed early speed along the rail, chased the leaders around the turn, then gave way. DIXIE BAND tracked the pace, was caught in tight on the turn and tired. FEARLESS COWBOY off slowly, was not a factor. CITY TROOPER was outrun while saving ground. GARY D chased the pace four wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. SILVER CRAFT showed brief speed and faded.
