SAINT ELIGIUS stalked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead in early stretch, edged clear at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to hold off MANHATTAN FOX. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run, then was angled back in and rallied between rivals to be just up for the place. SOLDIER FIELD rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss the place. WESTSHORE stalked the pace along the rail, eased out in the stretch and finished willingly. COLIZEO set the pace along the rail into the stretch, then weakened. CONCORDE'S FURY stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. BUZZIN READY saved ground and never threatened.
