Footnotes

SUNTRACER unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run, then rallied to take over late and won going away. FORT LARNED bumped with WITHDRAWAL at the start, raced three wide around the far turn, angled out and rallied to gain a brief lead at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. TWOJOHNSANDAJACK allowed to settle, steadied in traffic on the far turn, angled four wide, then rallied to gain the show. BEAR'S CHILL prompted the pace outside KIPPERS N' EGGS, made a run to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole, then gave way. STORMY THE CAT well placed after being steadied in the early going, checked in behind a rival on the far turn and failed to recover. LAUBURU tracked the pace into the stretch and tired. KIPPERS N' EGGS set the pace along the rail to the sixteenth pole, then faltered. KRIS AND ME saved ground and was done early. ROCKIN HEAT unhurried after bumping with WITHDRAWAL at the start, raced five wide around the far turn and never threatened. OLD MASTER EXPERT (GB) chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. WITHDRAWAL was outrun after being bumped between rivals at the start. SILENT TAP

tracked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faded.
