Footnotes

RIP ROARIN RITCHIE stalked the pace along the inside, was steadied briefly in behind the leaders at the top of the stretch, angled out and rallied to be just up at the wire. OFF THE PAGE vied for the lead along the rail with PARTY LAD, edged away from that rival inside the eighth pole, then just failed to last. DO YOU SMELL SMOKE tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. PARTY LAD vied for the lead outside OFF THE PAGE to the eighth pole and weakened. HOLY COMMAND chased the pace three wide around the turn, then gave way. PEPE was not a factor. DESIRE TO ACQUIRE trailed after hesitating at the start.
