STARSHIP PLEASANT tracked the pace, angled out leaving the far turn, then rallied to take over late and edged away. URQUIA reserved racing along the rail, eased out and was attempting to split rivals when steadied nearing the eighth pole, recovered and worked her way through traffic while rallying to be up for the place. KELLSTER rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn to take over at the top of the stretch, made the pace to inside the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. SWEET DREAMIN tracked the pace, made a run three wide around the far turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then weakened. LOVE SHACK (IRE) sluggish away from the gate, raced four wide and failed to menace. DESTINY JOY stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. LUCK BE THE LADY broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to set the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired.
