GURU chased the pace, rallied to take over leaving the far turn, opened a clear lead and remained clear to the wire under pressure, then was vanned off after the finish. HAPPY CLAPPER reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. WAKE UP COREY chased the pace along the inside into the stretch but didn't do enough late. BY LAND OR BY SEA tracked the pace three wide into the stretch but had no late response. MISS PALM KAT off slowly, failed to menace. BRAINFREEZE was not a factor. ANGELS CAN BE WILD set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. OH MANDIE tracked the pace four wide to the quarter pole, then faltered.
