Footnotes

MARCH TO VICTORY reserved off the pace, steadied on the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. NERGAL (FR) unhurried early, circled rivals four wide around the far turn, then closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. GIMME CREDIT rated off the pace, was blocked in behind a wall of horses from early stretch to well inside the eighth pole, then finished willingly to be up for the show. STEVIL pressed the pace outside CABERNEIGH, made a run to try that rival through the stretch, then was weakening when his rider lost his whip late. CABERNEIGH set the pace under pressure along the inside, responded when challenged through the stretch, then yielded in the final sixteenth and dead heated with BROAD RIVER. The latter, stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the leaders in the stretch, then gave way late and finished on even terms with CABERNEIGH. BIG STICK steadied along the inside on the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired.
