**Footnotes**

QUEST STAR quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. MAN FROM WICKLOW rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the final turn to reach contention, then didn't do enough late while up for the place. REDUIT (GB) outrun for more than a mile, angled wide in early stretch and rallied to be up for the show, then was vanned off after the finish. WHATA BRAINSTORM stalked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, weakened and was just edged for the show. MACAW (IRE) unhurried for a mile, steadied in tight quarters entering the final turn, then gained some ground in the drive without threatening. MR. LIVINGSTON chased the winner for more than a mile and tired. NORTH OF SIX well placed while saving ground, steadied entering the final turn and faltered. JUST LISTEN steadied in the early going, raced three wide and faded. MR. PLEASENTFAR (BRZ) showed little.
