Footnotes

BRIAN stalked the pace along the inside, eased out on the turn, rallied to catch PUREST FORM in early stretch, then drew off under urging. PHOTON raced with the pace three wide, dropped back on the turn, then was no match for the winner while proving best of the rest. PUREST FORM vied for the lead along the inside, edged away approaching the quarter pole, then tired in the drive. TIN PAN INDY unhurried early, improved his position without threatening. WILLY ELLIOT chased the pace four wide to midway of the turn, then faltered. TORMENTO bumped hard with PRIZED ASSAULT at the start and was not a factor. SILVER WINGS vied for the lead between horses to midway of the turn, then faded. BENNYFAX bumped hard with PRIZED ASSAULT at the start, saved ground and was through after a half mile. PRIZED ASSAULT trailed after being bumped hard between rivals at the start.
