TURMALINA unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and drew clear. NOBLE BALLETT steadied from close quarters on the backstretch, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to prove second best. TEA IS SERVED vied for the lead between horses into the stretch and gave way. OH SAY CAN YOU RUN hit the gate at the start, vied for the lead three wide around the turn and tired. MISS ABERDEEN tracked the pace duel around the turn and faltered. KIM'S DANCER off a step slowly, moved up to vie for the lead along the rail, then faded in the drive. LADY CAVALIER vied for the lead four wide around the turn and stopped.
