**Footnotes**

HOLLYWOOD LEFT was pressing the pace along the rail when steadied from inside RETIRE TO WHAT entering the turn, steadied again waiting for room in behind that rival leaving the turn, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and was all out to hold off BERGERAC. The latter, tracked the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss catching the winner. MAJOR MOMENTUM tracked the pace along the rail, eased out for the stretch run and was gaining at the finish. OUR FRIEND HARVEY reserved early, finished willingly along the inside. ASHTONOFUN allowed to settle, angled wide at the top of the stretch and closed with a belated rally. RETIRE TO WHAT showed speed along the inside to the sixteenth pole and weakened. CONGOR BAY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, swung wide for the stretch run and closed ground late without threatening. RUSTY CHARLIE chased the pace three wide around the turn and gave way. CHAIRMAN TUCKER was never close after breaking in the air.
