REVELATOR reserved off the pace, eased outside the leaders in the stretch, then rallied to be up in the final strides. ADARO vied for the lead off the rail, was outmoted by SIR PHILIP racing into the stretch, came back on to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. BIG WHISKEY NO ICE rated off the pace, advanced into contention around the far turn, then closed with a mild response to gain the show. SIR PHILIP rated off the pace, rallied along the rail to take over on the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. SHADOW WOOD allowed to settle

after hitting the gate at the start, advanced three wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then tired in the drive. HEART TRUST unhurried early, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered in the drive. HURRICANE LIGHT vied for the lead along the inside into the backstretch, then had nothing left. DRAMON moved up on the backstretch to vie for the lead three wide around the far turn, then faded. RENATOVITZ was not a factor. DALAXY showed early foot and was through after a half mile. AMIS LOUIS wide around the first turn, chased the pace to the far turn, then stopped. STARSHIP WARLOCK trailed after being checked at the start, then was being eased when he lost his rider on the far turn.
