TWILIGHT ECLIPSE stalked the pace along the inside, came around TEAKS NORTH on the final turn, then moved back to the rail, slipped through inside IOYA BIGTIME entering the stretch to gain the lead and drew away under urging. IOYA BIGTIME chased the pace, moved to take over after six furlongs, made the pace off the rail to nearing the top of the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while holding the place. NEWSDAD reserved for a mile, advanced four wide down the backstretch and around the final turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch the final time, then flattened out. BELO ACTEON (BRZ) stalked the pace three wide to midway of the final turn, then gave way. MUCHO MAS MACHO reserved off the pace, tired in the stretch run. TEAKS NORTH set the early pace along the rail, remained in contention into the final turn after losing the advantage, then faltered. DUCDUC was outrun. EMPIRE BUILDER was through after a mile. GOSSIP COLUMN was never close. TOTAL REWARD rated off the pace, was saving ground when steadied entering the clubhouse turn and faded.
