IRISH CATON chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, then drew away under urging. CARAVAN END rated off the pace, steadied on the far turn to avoid running up on HONALEE, got around that rival, then closed along the inside to be up for the place while no match for the winner. KATHY'S ESCOLHA unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch, then flattened out. VERY BECOMING failed to menace. MORETHANAMIRACLE reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. HONALEE sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace to quarter pole, then faltered. LITTLE IDOL well placed along the inside, faded leaving the far turn, was eased late and vanned off.
